

GASB Issues Guidance on Disclosure of Certain Capital Assets

The Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) released Statement No. 104, which provides new guidance on the disclosure of certain capital assets. This statement requires that specific types of capital assets, such as lease, intangible and subscription assets, be separately disclosed in financial note disclosures. Additionally, it sets requirements for reporting capital assets held for sale. The new rules are effective for fiscal years starting after June 15, 2025, with early application encouraged.

As the 2024 election approaches, the Postal Service is actively handling Election and Political Mail. The Postal Service's oversight agency plays a critical role in ensuring the secure and timely delivery of these materials. Special agents investigate any potential issues, and auditors conduct unannounced visits to 1,000 postal facilities nationwide to monitor election mail processes.
